

Egg in a bottle- Egg removal

Want to recycle your egg bottle to do another great experiment? Then try one of our methods of egg removal

To remove the egg from the bottle you need an increase in either temperature or air pressure to get the egg back out of the bottle.



1. Blow a big breath of air into the jar

The force of the air increases the pressure and this should allow the egg to slide on out - careful though you don't get egg on your face...



2. Pour baking soda into the jar, making sure you shake it all around the sides and opening of the jar.

Then add vinegar

This one is messy - best done outside!

3. Turn the bottle upside down then heat the end of the bottle with a hairdryer

Ask an adult for help as the bottle can get very hot



If all 3 fail for you then grab something that fits into the bottle like a teaspoon, fork, chopstick and break up the egg, shake egg bits out and put into the dishwasher
