Need:

Big Rock or Cave

Stones

Cave paint

Pigment is a Middle English word derived from the Latin pigmentum and pingere meaning 'to paint'.

How to:

Cave Paint

Use flowers and leaves crushed with rocks or ground down with stone mixed in with water for various colours

Use soils such as various colours of clay with water added for yellows, oranges and brown

Use charcoal mixed with water for blacks and grays

Use shells to hold your paints

Cave Paintbrush

Gather thin leaves or small sticks and bunch

Wrap a vine around these

Tie to a larger stick

Cave Paint

Use a sharp rock or shell to draw your picture on the rock
Then use your paints to paint the colour in
