- a. Resembles the hoof-like foot of an ostrich
- b. These are attached to rocks and structures in the sea
- c. These are a fan shaped shell
- d. These are triangle with a heavy face
- e. On shell the zig-zag pattern on resembles Arabic letters.
- f. Spiraled body with a straight shell
- g. These are buried in sand near low tide.
- h. These are a type of clam.
- i. These have been worn down over time.
- j. Are found in abundance on sandy beaches.
