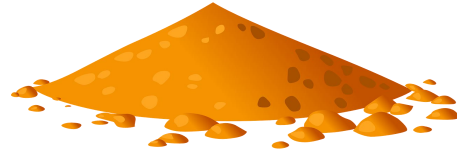


Kinetic Sand

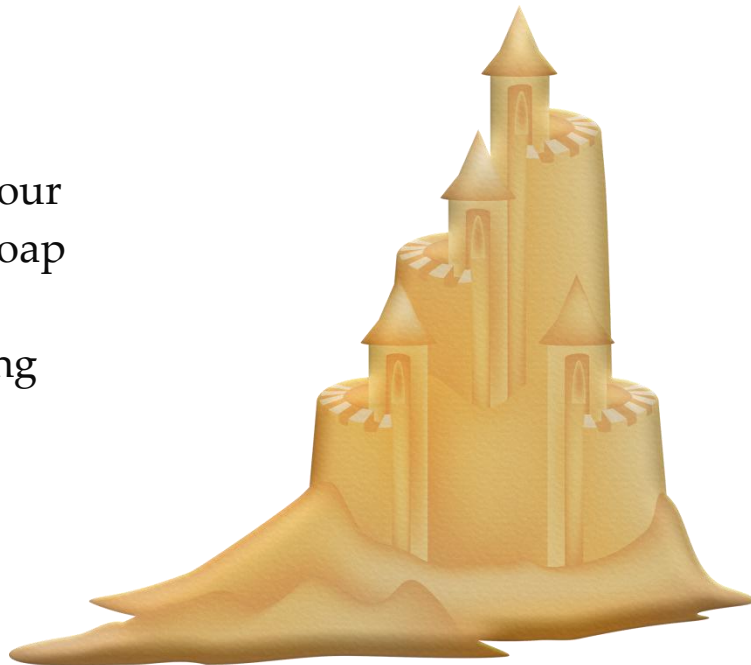


Kinetic sand usually contains a chemical called polydimethylsiloxane, also called dimethicone. You can buy dimethicone, but it's not readily available.

This is an alternative recipe without using dimethicone.

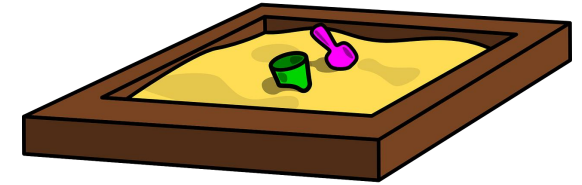
Need:

- 1 Cup Sand
- 3 Tbsp Cornflour
- 2 Tbsp Dish Soap
- 1 Tbsp Water
- Food Colouring



Kinetic sand is mold-able and squeezable sand.

It can be formed into many shapes.



It's like wet sand only it holds its shape.

How To:

Measure the sand, cornflour and dish soap into a bowl

Add a couple drops of food colouring

Slowly, while stirring add in the water until the consistency is right
