# **EGG**

Ostriches lay the largest eggs of any living land animal.

The largest egg on record weighed 2.589 kg was from an ostrich.

The Ostrich has the smallest eggs relative to body weight is the ostrich.

This is because its egg's weight is only 1.4-1.5% of the ostrich's total weight.

The toughest egg produced by any species of bird is the egg of the ostrich.

It can withstand the weight of a person (up to 115kg).
